Holistic Assessment Reports for Primary 1

We refer to our earlier letter dated 3 Mar 17 on Holistic Assessment reporting. The main purpose of holistic assessment is to provide meaningful feedback on how students are doing in achieving specific learning outcome. To this end, the school has designed a set of learning objectives for the various subjects. They serve to indicate the various aspects of your child's development and achievements. The descriptors given are derived from the daily classroom interactions and observations made by the teachers. You will be able to access your child's **Holistic Assessment Reports for Term 3** via MC Online with effect from **Wed, 23 Aug 17**. Attached in Annex A is a step-by-step guide to accessing your child's reports for the various subjects.

"No Straw Day" Campaign in Sengkang West on Fri, 22 Sep 17

The Anchorvale Community Club Management Committee (CCMC) and Youth Executive Committee (YEC) are promoting a "No Straw Day" campaign to all primary and secondary schools within Sengkang West. The objective of this campaign is to educate the public on the threats of single use plastic accessories such as straws and its effects on our environment and marine ecosystem.

The "No Straw Day" campaign is slated to be launched on **Fri, 22 Sep 17** at all schools within Sengkang West. It seeks to encourage individuals to be more conscientious towards the environment and to say "No" to single use plastics. Dr Lam Pin Min, Senior Minister of State for Health & Transport, and Grassroots Adviser to Sengkang West GRO will be making his round to the school to launch this campaign. There will also be a mini-roadshow by National Environment Agency and environmental groups such as Plastic-Lite and ZeroWasteSG on Tue, 19 Sep 17. The school would like to support the event and had since discouraged the use of straws in the canteen since early this year to inculcate the values of caring for the Earth.

Healthy Habits & Activities for the coming holidays

For this short break, we would like to encourage your child to cultivate healthy habits and spend the holidays meaningfully. Here are some suggestions:

- ✓ Encourage your child to participate in moderate to vigorous physical activities for about **60 min** a day.
- ✓ Visit the nearest community library and borrow a range of books. For the school holidays, the quota of books that can be borrowed is usually doubled.
- ✓ If you are travelling, get your child to do a mini-research on the culture, places of interest, historical background, geographical structure, famous people, etc. of the place you are visiting.
- ✓ Do subject revisions (via MC Online) on areas which your child needs to work on in preparation for the year-end assessments.
- ✓ Ensure your child cultivates the habit of sleeping and waking up early even during the holidays.



E-Homework on McOnline Portal

As you are aware, the school has been assigning **e-homework twice a month via MC Online portal**. The teachers have noticed that not all students complete their assignments online, despite having a computing device and internet connection at home. The school would like to impress upon the children that online assignments reinforce the daily work that the teachers give in class. Thus we seek your support to ensure that **your child completes his/her MC Online assignments**. Do refer to the Online Assignment Schedule that was issued to the students at the beginning of the term. Besides completing assignments, students can also go to the portal to revise on the subjects taught when they are free.

Nurturing Responsible Users of ICT

To inculcate the importance of being a responsible user of ICT, it is advisable for parents to go through the ground rules with your child on accessing mobile devices (phones, tablets, and computers) and internet:

1. Set time limit and enforce it as this helps children to manage their time.
2. Set objectives for the hour (or depending on the time limit set by parents) as this helps children to stay focussed on the task.
3. Agree on the websites that they are allowed to access as this sets the boundary for children to stay within the safe sites that you approve of.

First Day of School in Term 4

The last day for this term is **Wed, 30 Aug 17**. Students will report back to school on **Mon, 11 Sep 17** after the Term 3 holiday. As a practice, the school conducts its temperature-taking exercise over the first 3 days of school after each long weekend or term break. ***Kindly ensure that your child's thermometer is in working condition and your child has the thermometer in his/her bag every day.*** Should you have any queries, please feel free to call or email your child's Form Teacher.

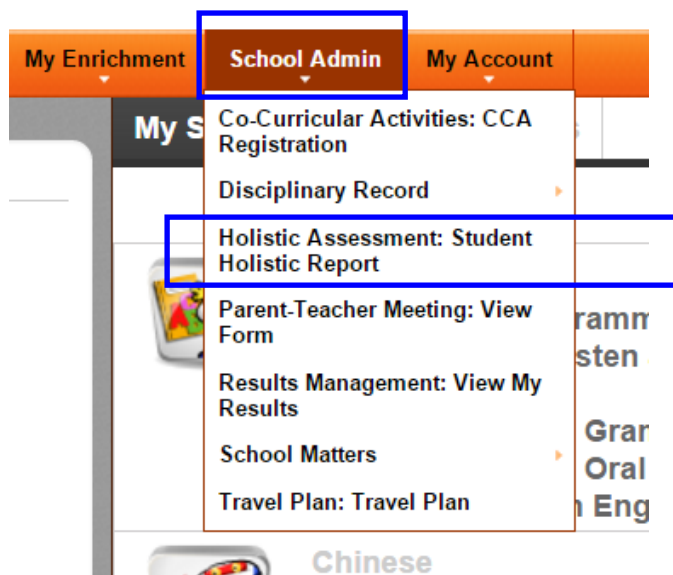

Instruction to access Student's Holistic Assessment (HA) Report

1. Login to Mc Online portal.
2. Look for "School Admin" at the toolbar at the top of the page.
3. Click on "Holistic Assessment: Student Holistic Report".



4. Click on the correct Term (Term 3) and select the subject report you would like to view at the left side of the page.
