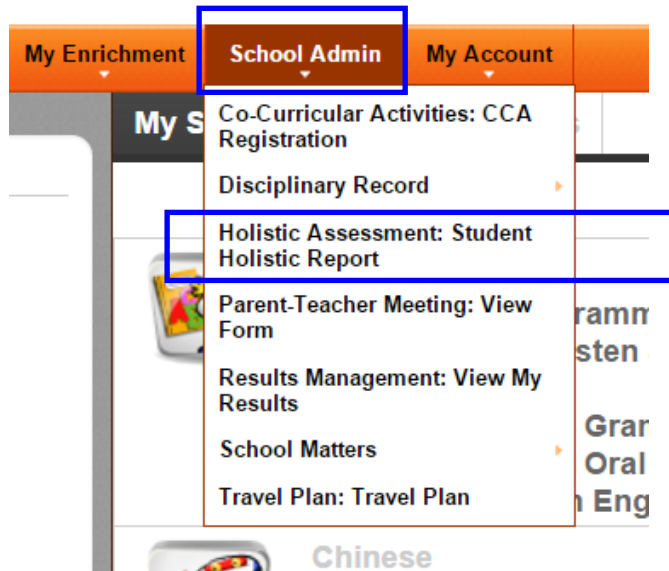


Instruction to access Student's Holistic Assessment (HA) Report

1. Login to Mconline portal.
2. Look for "School Admin" at the toolbar at the top of the page.
3. Click on "Holistic Assessment: Student Holistic Report".



4. Click on the correct Term (Term 1) and select the subject report you would like to view at the left side of the page.
