Enhancement to Ministry of Education Financial Assistance Scheme for Singapore Citizens

We are pleased to inform you that the Ministry Of Education (MOE) has enhanced the MOE Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS) for Singapore Citizens.

Starting from 1 April 2018, students who are Singapore Citizen from households with gross monthly household income (GHI) of \$2,750 and below, or per capita income¹ (PCI) of \$690 and below, will be eligible for the MOE FAS.

MOE FAS recipients are not required to pay school fees and standard miscellaneous fees. They are also eligible for free textbooks, school attire and transport subsidy². Those at pre-university will receive an annual bursary of \$900 in lieu of textbooks and school attire. All students can opt to pay their 2nd Tier miscellaneous fees from their Edusave account.

If you are eligible and wish to apply for the MOE FAS, please obtain a copy of the application form from the General Office and return the completed form to the school for processing. If you have any enquiries, please call the school at 6315 7600 for assistance.
