- The Health Promotion Board (HPB) has been closely monitoring the evolving COVID-19 situation and taking guidance from the advisories issued by the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Education (MOE).
- 2 HPB's School Health Service (SHS) and School Dental Service (SDS) will temporarily suspend all school-based health screening, immunisation and oral health programmes in primary and secondary schools with effect from 19 May 2021.
  - a. HPB will keep you updated as to when the SHS will be able to resume school-based health services in your child's school.
  - b. For the period of 24 May to 27 June 2021, following MOE's guidance, HPB's SDS may re-open the dental clinic in selected schools. We will keep your school informed if the school dental clinic re-opens.
  - c. In the meantime, for any urgent dental complaints, you may contact SDS listed below or any Polyclinics with dental services.
