

Student Well-being in School

- Conducive Learning Environment
 - Setting up of class rules & routines with students
 - Use of special rooms

- Break time
 - Recess
 - Snack break



Student Well-being in School

- Teacher-Student Relationship
 - Form Teacher Guidance Period (FTGP)
 - Chit-Chat
- Student-Student (Peer) Relationship
 - Informal interaction
 - Formal interaction



Student Well-being at Home

- Relationship with family members
 - Good relationship with parents & siblings helps to settle child in school
 - Parents can spend quality time by being:
 - □ a good listener
 - □ a role model of being a reasonable negotiator



Student Well-being at Home

PIO

- Time to rest, relax & play
 - Manage the amount of time spent on revision, on-screen play time & off-screen
 play time
 - Child to set timetable with parents' guidance
 - Negotiate on the amount of time spent to do different activities at home
 - Ensure sufficient sleep time

Student Well-being at Home

- Conducive learning environment
 - Free from distraction (child dependent)
 - Example: toys, siblings playing, etc
 - A clock / timer to manage time
 - Revision / Homework time
 - Full guidance at first, if necessary
 - Reduce parents' involvement over time gradually until child can gain independence
 - Praise child at the end of session (specify the things they have done well in)




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Programme for Active Learning
