Updates on Safe Management Measures (SMM) in school

As part of recent Ministry of Health's (MOH) ring-fencing efforts to mitigate the risk of wider, undetected community transmission of Covid-19, you or any of your household members may receive an SMS from MOH with either a "Health Risk Warning" or "Health Risk Alert". If you or any of your household members receive such SMS from MOH, please take note of the following:

	Measures to be taken	
	For Students who have received "Health Risk Warning" or "Health Risk Alert" SMS	For Students with Household Members who have received "Health Risk Warning" or "Health Risk Alert" SMS
Health Risk Warning Persons identified to be a casual contact of a COVID-19 case, or have visited specific higher-risk hotspots on the same day as a COVID-19 case.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students are to be placed on AA (Approved Absence) and will only be allowed to return to school if their exit PCR swab test is negative. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students are to be placed on AA (Approved Absence) and can return to school as long as their household member's entry PCR swab test is negative, and their household member is well.
Health Risk Alert Persons identified to have visited hotspot areas or their vicinity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will be strongly encouraged to be tested and monitor their own health. While they will be allowed to return to school, they will be advised to minimize their social interactions for the duration specified by MOH. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students may return to school.

Please inform your child's form teacher immediately if you, your child or any of your household members receive such SMS from MOH so that the school can provide the appropriate guidance to your child if necessary.
