What is the Mother Tongue Support Programme (MTSP)?

A customised programme to support students in the learning of Mother Tongue Language (MTL) in Primary 3 and 4.

What are our belief and objectives?

We believe that every child can learn MTL. We hope to:

- Develop students as Active learners of MTL
- Build their confidence in learning MTL
- Making Mother Tongue a Living language by using the language in daily life
- Provide Engaging and enjoyable learning experience

What are the key features?

- Smaller class size
 - The recommended class size for MTSP is either 8-12 students or 9% of the cohort per MTL, whichever is lesser.
- MTSP lesson are conducted during curriculum time.
 - Depending on school manpower resourcing and timetable arrangement,
 some MTSP lessons may be conducted after school hours.
- Targeted approach in teaching oracy and literacy skills
 - Explicit and skills-focused
 - Systematic and progressive (simple to complex)
- Use of customised learning materials
 - Multi-sensory
 - Fun and engaging
- Immersive language environment to enable students to learn MTL with confidence and joy
- Taught by trained MTSP teachers

- More individualised attention
- Supportive learning environment
- Experiences of success





- We will:
 - Inform you of your child's progress regularly
 - Provide ideas and suggestions to support your child's learning, where necessary
 - Share strategies to engage your child in MTL learning at home in a fun and meaningful manner

Supporting Your Child in MTL Learning

Do	Avoid
Believe that your child can learn and wants to learn	Placing excessive attention on marks
Encourage your child to learn MTL	 Making comparison between your child
 Praise your child for his/her good effort and progress 	and other children's achievement
Set incremental and achievable goals with your child	
 Communicate with the school teacher regularly on your child's progress at home 	

Practical tips to help your child learn MTL

- Speak to your child in MTL as often as possible
- Show interest in your child's MTL learning
- Learn with your child, learn from your child
- Have regular conversations with your child about his/her MTL experience in class
- Use a variety of resources to extend your child's language and literacy skills in MTL
- Encourage and accompany your child to read books or visit the library regularly
- Provide a conducive environment for learning MTL set up a reading corner at home, watch suitable TV programmes in MTL
