





- 1. All upper primary students (P3 onwards) **are strongly encouraged** to be involved in CCA as part of their holistic education.
- 2. Each primary student will only be allocated 1 CCA. Participation in additional CCA may only be allowed on a case-by-case basis.
- 3. Students must remain in their CCA for the whole year so that they can deepen their skills, knowledge and friendships in the CCA.



CCA Guidelines

- 4. Future School Representatives may be required to train on Mondays/Tuesdays/Thursdays afternoons and/or during the school holidays.
- 5. Students must meet at least 85% attendance criteria before their CCA participation can be recorded in their Student Holistic Report Card.



CCA Guidelines

6. 1 CCA Leader would be selected from P4 onwards to assist the CCA teachers.

7. Participation in external activities for the purpose of self-enrichment or social interaction as well as those that are already offered in school will not be considered as a CCA.

8. Transfer of CCA request is in Term 4 Week 5 to 7
