Guidelines for Parent Volunteers (PV)

Dear Parents,

Thank you for your interest to becoming a PV. Here're some tips to make your involvement in our school-home partnerships meaningful and sustainable.

1. Role of Parent Volunteer (PV)

- a. Complement the school by **aligning with the school's objectives**, supporting and strengthening the school's programmes to improve our children's well-being and learning.
- b. Support teachers in managing the **discipline and safety** of children during school duties or learning journeys. For learning journeys, in particular, do:
 - i. Act in consultation with the teacher-in-charge of the class where itinerary, toilet & food/drink breaks (if applicable) are concerned. Teachers-in-charge will be responsible for making the decisions for the group.
 - ii. Children who are unwell come under the care of the teacher-in-charge while the PV takes charge of the rest of the group.
