<p>P3 Critical & Creative Thinking in Mathematics Through engaging and interesting activities, aligned to the P3 Mathematics syllabus, this programme seeks to improve students' attitudes, skills and knowledge towards Mathematics. It provides students with opportunities to exhibit the necessary thinking skills to refine and apply their Maths knowledge to various real-life situations. There would also be avenues where students explore creative ways to solve non-routine types of Mathematics problems. <p>P3 Tchoukball Tchoukball is the fastest hand ball sport in the world today. Invented in the late 1960s, tchoukball is a team sport of 7 players that unites all key sporting skills, athleticism, concentration, respect for oneself and the opposition and teamwork. The programme aims to develop student's fundamental movement skills as they learn the various aspects of the game. Parents would have to **make alternative transport arrangement** for children taking school bus if they are staying back for the enrichment programme. The school bus vendor can make arrangement to pick your child only if there is a minimum number of 8 students staying in the same area taking the school bus. We regret to inform you that alternative school bus arrangement is dependent on numbers and subject to availability of the drivers. Please liaise directly with the school bus vendor.

To sign up your child for the enrichment programme, please do so via the Enrichment Online Signup Form at <http://bit.ly/SDPS-P3-Sem1-2018-Enrichment> between **9 Jan 18, 08:00 & 11 Jan 18, 21:00**. An email will be sent to you by **Tue, 16 Jan 18** to confirm if your child's application is successful and he/she has been allocated a place.

Please take note of the following payment details for successful applicants.

For students who are Singapore Citizens, the enrichment fee will be deducted from your child's Edusave account and no further action is required from parents.

For students who are Permanent Residents and International Students, please print the confirmation letter and enclosed it in an envelope together with the payment in exact amount in cash/cheque and submit them to your child's Form Teacher on **Wed, 17 Jan 18**. Cheques should be made payable to **Springdale Primary School** with your child's name, class and name of the programme written at the back of the cheque.

Do note that the school will not refund any payment made should any child be absent or withdrawn from the programme.

Lastly, please note the lunch and dismissal arrangements for students staying back for after-school enrichment programmes:

1. Lunch Arrangement

Please ensure that your child has sufficient money for both recess and lunch, since he/she will be staying back for the enrichment programme in the afternoon. For security reason, please note that parents **would not be allowed** to come into the canteen.

2. Dismissal

Please note that the Rear Gate will be opened from 3 pm to 3.15 pm for the convenience of parents or caregivers who are picking their children and walking home. For parents who are picking your child up by car, please instruct your child to wait for you at the Foyer.

If your child usually takes the school bus home, please remind him/her about the **alternative** transport arrangement on enrichment days. Do let him/her know specifically where he/she is supposed to wait for you. Students who are in the school Student Care Centre will be directed to the centre accordingly once the enrichment programme finishes.

As the programme finishes at 3 pm, we seek your understanding that students may be released to the dismissal points slightly after that. Should you have further queries, please feel free to call or email your child's Form Teacher.
